As a photography fellow for the National Repertory Orchestra, you'll gain valuable experience collaborating with guest artists, the orchestra manager, production staff, musicians, and the audience. The fellowship will tackle a wide range of daily assignments, in-house and in the field. The fellow reports to the Director of Marketing and will work closely with the CEO, Director of Operations, Director of Development, Director of Finance, other fellows and staff, musicians and guest conductors and artists.

**Duties and Responsibilities:**

- **Photography Duties:** Scheduling and conducting photo shoots. Editing photos, ensuring photo files are stored for future access. Work with the Director of Marketing and the Marketing Fellow to coordinate the use of photos. Create a portfolio of high-quality photos to be used for marketing campaigns.
- **Other Duties:** Attend rehearsals, outreach events, special events and concerts. Assist with a variety of operational and administrative duties, including but not limited to set-up and clean-up of special events, answering phones, computer data entry, distributing marketing materials, and selling merchandise.
- Other Duties as assigned.

**Qualifications:**

- Must be self-motivated, able multi-task, work in a fast-paced environment, and meet deadlines.
- Possess strong story-telling abilities, a positive attitude, and excellent communication skills. Experience with video/film techniques, interviewing, and documentary research.
